> (akpm: what lock \_does\_ protect sb->s\_flags?)

In general s\_flags is changed under sb->s\_umount (write) semaphore  
inside various get\_sb(), fill\_super() and remount\_fs() filesystem functions.  
Exceptions are:

- 1) do\_emergency\_remount -- where s\_umount(read) is taken,
- 2) various filesystem error-handlers (like ext3\_abort() and reiserfs\_abort()),  
when filesystem "remounted" to read-only without any locks.
