> [linux-2.6.19-rc3-mm1]\$ ARCH=i386 make

> CHK include/linux/version.h

> CHK include/linux/utsrelease.h

> CHK include/linux/compile.h

> GEN .version

> CHK include/linux/compile.h

> UPD include/linux/compile.h

> CC init/version.o

> LD init/built-in.o

> LD .tmp_vmlinux1

> arch/i386/kernel/built-in.o(.rodata+0x520): In function `sys_call_table':

> : undefined reference to `sys_kevent_get_events'

> arch/i386/kernel/built-in.o(.rodata+0x524): In function `sys_call_table':

> : undefined reference to `sys_kevent_ctl'

> arch/i386/kernel/built-in.o(.rodata+0x528): In function `sys_call_table':

> : undefined reference to `sys_kevent_wait'

> make: *** [.tmp_vmlinux1] Error 1

> [linux-2.6.19-rc3-mm1]\$ grep KEVENT .config

> CONFIG_GENERIC_CLOCKEVENTS=y

> # CONFIG_KEVENT is not set
