Im tyring to setup VPS with OpenVZ.

I used vzctl command. vzctl set 101 --ipadd [IP]

and checked conf cat /etc/sysconfig/vz-scripts/101.conf IP_ADDRESS="[IP]"

After that, Start OpenVZ and enter. But, Can not connect network. Because, VE's subnet mask is not HW's.

HW's subnet mask 255.255.255.248 VE's subnet mask 255.255.255.255

I tried to change subnet mask and restart network.

vi /etc/sysconfig/network-scripts/ifcfg-venet0:0 NETMASK=255.255.255.248 #NETMASK=255.255.255.255

/etc/init.d/network restart

VE's success to connect HW. But, after restart OpenVZ, subnet mask back to 255.255.255.255

Anyone know set subnet mask? I could not find command in vzctl --help.
