> Hello, I think I'm not entirely understanding how vzsplrit works.

>

> I want to split my server up into 20 ve's. So I ran this:

>

> vzsplrit -n 20 -f vps.mytest

>

> Which creates the appropriate file. Which I use as my template when creating

> new VE's. Great.

>

> But when I run vzcalc on one of the ve's that I've created with the template

> made with vzsplrit, this is what it shows:

>

> [root@vz ~]# vzcalc 101

> Resource Current(%) Promised(%) Max(%)

> Memory 0.28 20.45 22.46

>

Try vzsplrit with "-s 0", the regular way it takes swap into account which is generally a bad idea.
