The first time I did not compile the kernel myself. I followed the instructions on "Installation on Debian" [wiki.openvz.org](http://wiki.openvz.org/wiki.openvz.org/Installation_on_Debian) (see [http://wiki.openvz.org/Installation_on_Debian](http://wiki.openvz.org/wiki.openvz.org/Installation_on_Debian)). I assumed that an 'aptitude install' is always safe. The configuration file that comes along with that kernel has CONFIG_BLK_DEV_PIIIX=y
