I personally do the following for adding second IP address on my host.

```
#!/bin/bash
```

```
IP=217.67.117.132
```

```
GW=217.67.117.129
```

```
MASK=27
```

```
ip addr add $IP/$MASK dev eth0
```

```
ip rule add from $IP table 6
```

```
ip route add default dev eth0 via $GW table 6
```
