Hi Cahya,

unfortunately you cannot mount ext3 inside VPS too: mount tries to start kernel thread for journal. virtuoizzo do not allow to execute in side VPS any kernel threads: it is unclear who should stop it and how to do it when the VPS is stopped? what should be calculated the resources allocated by kernel thread? what we should do, when the kernel thread requested the resourced over than allowed by the VPS -- As far as I see it is not a simple questions.

On the other hand -- you can mount devices/partitions with ext2 filesystem, which is not required the kernel threads.

And again I would note that you may mount any devices/partitions in VE0 but to the mountpoint inside VPS area, and I do not see any advantages to do it exclusive inside VPS.
