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Hi zenny,

The debian install of vzctl package follows the "filesystem hierachy standard (fhs) ->
<http://www.pathname.com/fhs/>
so the VZROOT is set to /var/lib/vz.
For a "backward" compability, you can create a symbolic link to /vz:

```
# ln -s /var/lib/vz /vz
```

In your case, mount your seperate partion to /var/lib/vz,
or change the vz.conf setting to your mountpoint.

e.g:

```
LOCKDIR=/var/lib/vz/lock  
DUMPPDIR=/var/lib/vz/dump  
TEMPLATE=/var/lib/vz/template  
VE_ROOT=/var/lib/vz/root/$VEID  
VE_PRIVATE=/var/lib/vz/private/$VEID
```

Change /var/lib/vz/ to your needed path
