make sure your VE doesn't experience resource shortages
(check failcnt column in /proc/user_beancounters).

next, check that mysql is shutdown gracefully in VE.

For this you can check whether manual mysql and/or VE stop
before node reboot helps.

> I have a serious problem occurring on my VPS when there is a hardware
> reboot (as opposed to individual VPS reboot).

>

> My java application runs under Tomcat and connects to MySQL.

>

> I have installed MySQL 5 and use this. Both tomcat and mysql are
> installed under /usr/local/

>

> When the hardware reboots, there are connectivity issues with my
> database, the application seems unable to connect to MySQL under certain
> circumstances, however the background thread that runs in my app CAN
> connect, which leads to database synchronisation issues.

>

> As a result I have to login via SSH and reboot the VE once the node has
> booted.

> What could be the root cause of this and what can be done to help.
