I'm struggling to setup veth in CT, I just followed the "Simple configuration with virtual Ethernet device" part in http://wiki.openvz.org/Virtual_Ethernet_device step by step but it doesn't work for me. I can't ping other machines except CT0, and when I type `brctl` show it gets nothing, is `vmbr0` supposed to be the default bridge??

Another question is how this veth connect to the physical NIC? According to the manual online we needn't to specify which physical NIC to map, so how does OpenVZ know which NIC is mapped to the veth in CT?? Is there any manual in detail about how to setup veth in CT? Thanks very much to reply. I'll appreciate it.
