If you have kernel crashes please follow these instruction  
[http://wiki.openvz.org/When\\_you\\_have\\_an\\_oops#If\\_you\\_have\\_had\\_an\\_oops](http://wiki.openvz.org/When_you_have_an_oops#If_you_have_had_an_oops)

shortly:

- please switch to last released kernel, your issue can be fixed already.
- please check your hardware and be sure that it isn't hardware-related issue
- please configure remote console (serial- or netconsole) and to save kernel messages on another node.

Alternatively you configure kdump, it allows to save kernel core dump. Kernel messages of crashed kernel can be extracted from this core dump
