/var/lib/vz/private# ls
```

```
101 102 103 104 105 106 107 108 109
```

today the 102 server stopped working.when i looked into the 102 it contains only the following files

```
/var/lib/vz/private/102# ls  
proc sys var
```

then i created a new virtual server 109 it contains the following file

```
/var/lib/vz/private/109# ls
```

```
bin boot dev etc fastboot home lib lib64 media mnt opt proc root sbin selinux srv sys  
tmp usr var
```

and i don't no what happened. when i tried to start the server 102 it gives me following error

```
/var/lib/vz/private/109# vzctl start 102  
Starting container ...  
Container is mounted  
Unable to open /var/lib/vz/root/102/sbin/init-logger: No such file or directory  
Unable to copy init-logger  
Not enough resources to start environment  
Container start failed (try to check kernel messages, e.g."dmesg | tail")  
Container is unmounted
```
