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Hey,

I made a template of a openvz container using the document here  
[wiki.openvz.org/Creating\\_a\\_CentOS\\_5.0\\_Template](http://wiki.openvz.org/Creating_a_CentOS_5.0_Template)

When I created VM's using this template all the cron times changed and each container had a different cron time than the image as well as different from each other.

Cron file in the image

And now the same file in the container that were created using this template

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I figured out, this is because of the postcreate.sh script, but I think this is wrong, and that this feature should be optional and not mandatory.

I have a setup where we run completely identical servers and the cron times need to be same on all of them, apart from other stuff.

Normally we create our own image and then using puppet create other containers, due to the postcreate.sh script, the cron times in the newly created containers change and we have to again manually set the cron times on all the containers, which defeats the entire purpose of creating a custom image and automated deploy.

I think openvz designers should consider this and make this feature optional.

I believe this is a wanted feature in general. If you look at it from the perspective of server load, distributing cron times makes sense. So most HN admins wouldn't want cron to be run at exactly the same time on all the VMs. But having a switch to disable this for cases such as yours also makes sense, IMHO.
