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I'm using Proxmox 1.9 distro for my needs. By default it's web interface doesn't allow to mix network types for one CT. But I wanted to setup a mixed network within one CT. My HN has 2 physical interfaces. So I've created a CT with veth interface bridged with eth0 via vbr0 bridge. Then I've edited /etc/vz/conf/101.conf so it looks like:

```
IP_ADDRESS="192.168.A.B"  
NETIF="ifname=eth0,bridge=vbr0,mac=XX:XX:XX:XX:XX:XX,host_ifname=veth101.0,host_mac  
=YY:YY:YY:YY:YY:YY"
```

That way I have both venet and eth0 (veth device) inside CT. It seems to be working as intended. But because I didn't find any info on a setup like this I want to ask if there are any drawbacks or possible problems with such a setup.
