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Hi,

after migrating several containers to a new HN using vz migrate, we experience issues with some of these containers (using the gentoo-openvz-x86-2008.11.30.tar.gz-Template).

When I try to start such a container using `vzctl start <CTID>`, the container gets the status "running", and `vzlist` shows up 4 processes.

```
CTID  NPROC  STATUS  IP_ADDR  HOSTNAME
451   4   running  <IP>    <HOST>
```

After a few seconds, the container stops and remains within the status "mounted". I assume there is a problem during the init, but I found no possibility how to get the output of `/sbin/init` when starting the VM.

Any suggestions here?

`/var/log/vzctl.log` / `dmesg` do not show any errors.

2.6.32-openvz-feoktistov.1

running on 2.6.32.
