The session just locks up and I have to close the window. If I leave top running this does not happen. My ClientAliveInterval is set to 0. This is Mac iTerm connecting to a CentOS6.3, with CentOS 6.3 host.

The other solution which I now use and seems to work for all routers is sending null keep alive SSH packets. That is what WinSCP calls it. Maybe iTerm has something similar.
