> It seems to be that Debian 6/64 cannot support(use) vswap
> and I have this error message.

> Does Debian Squeeze 6/64 run in a VPS with Vswap?

VSwap is a feature provided by the kernel, and it is unrelated to a
distribution
that you run inside an OpenVZ container.

So this question is not Debian-specific, thus replying to users@ in Cc.

>
> Any ideas about how I can fix that error?

You haven't provided enough information to find out what is wrong.
Missing info is: your kernel version, /proc/user_beancounters contents etc.
