After installing zimbra multi-server setup on openvz containers, I realized that when zimbra services are running, the size of the disk space increases whenever i execute `df -h` until it reaches 100%.

Am running centos-6.4-x86_64 with openvz-2.6.32-042stab076.8.

I verified that this happens on both ploop and simfs.
