Hi,

I can not reboot any of running OpenVZ VPses.
Instead of reboot they stop and it is required to boot them from Control Panel.

It is easy to repro it:
logging via SSH to running VPS
then issue command "reboot"
and server shuts down instead of boot again.

The problem affects all VPSes as well running previously OK as well new ones

I run there SolusVM and it seems problem is since Master Migration

I opened ticket by Solus but the state is OpenVZ problem.
