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Hi, it is not that simple. Think of it this way.... can you easily convert Windows XP service pack 2 to Windows 98SE? Windows 2003 -> Windows ME? Changing any OS to any other OS, even though both may use the linux kernel is not trivial and cannot be accomplished in any single command. There are some distro conversion procedures from Redhat 9 to Fedora, however those procedures are pre-planned and well thought out using RPM depedency chains. In short, there is no way to do what you are asking..
