List all processes and which VE they live in

```
ps -A | awk '{print $1}' | xargs vzpid
```

Or... list all processes in a VE (assuming they have a good, working "ps")

```
vzctl exec VEID ps -A
```

Or... (there's probably a better way?)

```
ps -A | awk '{print $1}' | xargs vzpid | egrep "[[:space:]]VEID[[:space:]]"
```
