I noticed that the container couldn't send email, so I checked the logs and saw it couldn't reach the SMTP server. Ping was also not possible. Once I flushed iptables I am able to contact everything as normal, however this isn't a good solution. Does anyone know how this could have happened? The IP/DNS stayed the same, it's only the host that has changed.
