The Confixx Installation Manual for virtuozzo tells me to run

sysctl -w kernel.vzprivrange="1 10000"

to create /proc/vz/hwinfo on the VPS. When running this command I keep getting:

sysctl -w kernel.vzprivrange="1 10000" error: 'kernel.vzprivrange' is an unknown key

Without the /proc/vz/hwinfo the registration of Confixx fails.

I am running openvz on Debian 64bit. VPS System is Suse9.3 64bit.
