I just installed a fresh Centos 6.5 and OpenVZ kernel on an IBM X3650 M4. After restart the boot sticks after

The kernel is the latest stab: 042stab084.12

I dont even know what info to provice. No panic, not any messages apart from this.

This was the first restart after installing openvz kernel.

UPDATE: then I realized it wont start neither with the stock kernel ./ I'll try to reinstall it tomorrow. Hope it'll turn out differently will feed back.

Any ideas?
