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OK. Let's go step by step.

- 1) If you have installed OpenVZ kernel from rpm than there is no NFS-server support. You see "nfs 101268 0" in Ismod output, but this is module to use NFS-client. To use NFS-server on HN you should recompile OpenVZ kernel with CONFIG_NFSD parameter enabled.
- 2) Anywat you won't be able to mount NFS inside VE, 'cause NFS filesystem isn't virtualized.
- 3) Why do you need it? If you wish just export some directories to VEs from HN just use --bind option of mount.
