I accidentally deleted vms, its files just disappeared i dont know how.

So what i did is that i restored backups by vldump, but result is that i can SSH into a VM etc, i can also use their IP to access control panel on VPS, BUT, domains not working, domains pointed to all VPS...

newly created VM works with domains, but when i restore my backup tgzs, websited/domains dont resolve, i see VPS software, zones are OK, issue is in VM openvz files, but im totally unsure how to discover cause.
