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Hi,

I love OpenVZ! I've been using it for about 2 years (rock solid!). My HN is running CentOS 5.8 and I'd like to migrate it to a vswap kernel on CentOS 6.5. Is it possible? Should be safer to backup every container and start from a brand new install? (I know I can move containers (5.8 -> 6.5) without problems, I'm asking to update HN). I did a search on the forum but didn't find anything.

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It's possible and AFAIK, openvz devels are recommending the usage of RHEL 6 kernel on RHEL 5 systems (same goes for all RHEL 5 clones, CentOS, Scientific Linux, etc.).
