I was going through the tests on http://wiki.centos.org/TipsAndTricks/BrokenVserver#head-bf758229f34d795cfd2b806bfce27df3131e5e63 (The url has a space in the middle because of the url restriction on me till I post 10 messages), trying the sudo rpm -Va command. Here is part of the output:
