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The recommended way of installing OpenVZ 7 is to use baremetal installation
https://download.openvz.org/virtuozzo/releases/openvz-7.0.3-479/x86_64/iso/

Or you can install commercial Virtuozzo 7: <https://virtuozzo.com/products/virtuozzo-containers/>
(press "Try Virtuozzo now", you'll get the link to iso image immediately on your email).
If you disable vzlicmon service in that installation, you'll get exactly OpenVZ 7.
