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Dear arunksasi,

could you please clarify -- is it happen inside container or on host?

If this observed on host -- please check state of `ip_contrack_disable_ve0` option of `nf_contrack` module.

(in Vz6 we disable contracks on host by default, but in openvz6 it should be enabled)

If this happen inside container -- please check state of `NETFILTER` option in container's config file `NETFILTER="full"` should enable using of NAT rules.
