I was a happy user from OVZ6. I could recommend it for any environment. Then OVZ7 came and i was able to use it, although it become more complicated.

I now try to use OVZ9, but it is not stable at all.

- Containers starts with lot of warnings about using deprecated commands from scripts.
- After server boot not all containers starting up. Always random.
- Container restart action freezes and then "forcibly" able to stop container after minuted of wait.

I wonder if OVZ8/9 are production ready or are just unusable public demo? What i understand that there is a "<https://www.virtuozzo.com/virtuozzo-hybrid-server/>". Is it still OVZ6 or OVZ7 based?

Anyone able to use OVZ in the production and what version?
