I suppose you're also using disk quota in VEs? ("yes" by default installation) If this is the case, then the problem is known. OpenVZ supports per VE disk quotas only if VE resides on ext2/ext3 filesystems.

I see two ways for you: if you need quota - use ext2/ext3, if you don't need quota, then make quota off (using vz.conf file) and df should report right information.
