In /etc/yp.conf I have: domain xxxxxx broadcast This works on non-virtual machines. I also tried setting a server name, but it still hangs.

Our network uses an unusual netmask: 255.255.248.0 Could that be causing a problem?

There's nothing on the wiki about NIS.

My virtual machines are CentOS 4.
