OpenSuSE 10 template is available from <http://download.openvz.org/template/precreated/beta/>

The only problem with it as it requires CONFIG\_VE\_SYSFS option turned on, which is off by default, so you'll need to recompile the kernel to get it working. We will solve the problem with the future releases of kernel and vzctl (this option will be per-VPS).

Also, there is a thread somewhere on this forum -- a guy claims he created some SuSE template, and will create more soon. Try to search the forum!
