I think this is rather an Ensim issue than an OpenVZ issue. We could make a kernel provide (empty) /proc/devices file inside a VPS, but I'm not sure if this will help since the next issue Ensim will complain about would be that the file is empty.

Can you try (or have you tried) contacting Ensim folks regarding your problem? If it works on VZ 2.6 that means they probably have some check that tells this is a VPS and some stuff is skipped (or done alternatively) in this case.
