I'm an amateur in working with kernels, so I tried to get kernel 2.6.9-023stab040.1, after install it with 'dkgp -i ...' modprobe breaks with failure 'Error inserting ... Operation not permitted'. I can't find anything in the logs. Can someone help me?
