Error: initscripts conflicts with kernel < 2.6.12

I then tried following things, including setting up a local centos-5 yum mirror and recreating the initscripts rpm after having compiled it on my box, but I keep getting the same error.

My kernel is 2.6.18-ovz028stab023.1

Hi,

I also tryed to make centos 5 template by this way, and have same troubles as you. Next step was to try to make template from fedora-core-5 (cp -pr /vz/template/fedora-core/5 /vz/template/centos/5z) then fix gpg-key, mirrors in yum.conf and yum cache dir. vzpkgcache -f centos-5z-i386-minimal was successful, and creating new VE based on this template (centos-5z-i386-minimal) too. For now VE work without problems but I still expect some ... in any case.

If you wish, try this ... until oficial vztmpl-centos-5 release.
