How-to setup OpenVZ on openSUSE 10.2? I have downloaded 2.6.18-openvz kernel from the openvz website, tried to install:

error: Failed dependencies:

initscripts >= 5.83 is needed by kernel-2.6.18-ovz028stab031.1.i686 mkinitrd >= 3.5.5 is needed by kernel-2.6.18-ovz028stab031.1.i686

I had 2 dependencies, which I could not resolve so I forcefully installed this kernel (with --nodeps), but it still doesn't works - even not added itself to the GRUB menu, plus it cannot be uninstalled now due to some stupid error:

opensuse:~ # rpm -e kernel-2.6.18-ovz028stab031.1.i686 error: %preun(kernel-2.6.18-ovz028stab031.1.i686) scriptlet failed, exit status 1

Is there a way to get OpenVZ working on openSUSE?

Hello
You have to add it manually to /boot/grub/menu.lst after running "mk_initrd". This works fine for me on SuSE 10. You could even use both kernels as alternate boot.
