Ah, it's enough to know that you're using 2.6.20 OVZ series. For this series (even for the latest 2.6.20-ovz005) meminfo patches are not ported from 2.6.18, so this feature doesn't work on this series at the moment. It'll be done later.

This WARNING is absolutely painless, so if you don't need meminfo feature, just don't pay attention on it. Once we port meminfo patches to 2.6.20 series and you upgrade your kernel - it'll disappear.

But if you need meminfo feature immediately, you should stick to 2.6.18 series for a while.
