First, you should enable port forwarding as per [http://wiki.openvz.org/Quick\\_installation#sysctl](http://wiki.openvz.org/Quick_installation#sysctl) (i.e. modify /etc/sysctl.conf and then run sysctl -p)

Next, you do not want that IP address to present on your eth interface -- remove it from there.
