I just installed OpenVZ over FC6, fresh install, no updates, and now I have no X booting from OpenVZ, but ok booting from FC6.

OpenVZ, rpm build download:

FC6:

Hello,

Probably the reason is that not all required drivers are compiled in kernel. You can do the following things:

- 1) recompile OpenVZ kernel with needed options enabled
- 2) use precompiled OpenVZ kernel based on rhel5. This kernel is compiled with many various drivers, so I'm pretty sure X will work.
