I need to load sd\_mod into my kernel in order to use my SATA RAID card. I can load this correctly when using the normal Linux kernel but not with the OpenVZ kernel.

```
[root@localhost /]# modprobe sd_mod  
FATAL: Module sd_mod not found.
```

When I try to load the sd\_mod from the normal kernel to the OpenVZ kernel I get...

```
insmod: error inserting '/lib/modules/2.6.9-55.ELsmp/kernel/drivers/scsi/sd_mod.ko': -1 Invalid  
module format
```

My distribution is CentOS4.5

Any ideas what I can do to get this working?
