I'd be interested in helping put together a howto to do this manually. Presumably this can be done fairly painlessly by setting up two identical hardware nodes (same templates, sample configs, cache etc and copying over the vz private area (via rsync, scp etc..) together with individual VPS config files.

First copy all data, then stop the VPS on the source node and run rsync. Stopping is necessary if you don't want to have corrupted data. I don't know if a special tool for that is really needed, the shell script which does such migration is quite simple.
