root@ovz101:/var/log# mv /etc/localtime /etc/localtime.old

Here we create a symlink to the correct TZ. Don't forget to change out the "<Canada>/<Easter>" with your TZ.

root@ovz101:/var/log# In -s /usr/share/zoneinfo/<Canada>/<Eastern> /etc/localtime
