vzdum, per default excludes some files excluded in directory, like /var/log/ , /tmp/ , /var/tmp/ and /var/run/ ; but you can override this feature, see man page of vzdum

--exclude-path REGEX

exclude certain files/directories.

Standard exclusions are disabled in this case.

You can use this option more than once to specify multiple exclude paths.
