I had same issue some time ago and blast why, oh why did I not write down how I fixed it

Anyway:

1. VE is on a public IP;
2. DNS lookup does not work;
3. Ping on IP works;
4. /etc/resolv.conf is same as on HW (dns lookup on HW works);
5. VE can reach nameservers from resolv.conf

I believe this has something to do with routing from VE to HW to internet.

On HW:
