/dev/loop0: Permission denied
```

```
Application_Server_sxb # mount -t msdos -o loop=/dev/loop2 disk-image fs  
ioctl: LOOP_SET_FD: Operation not permitted
```

loop0 is mounted with mount -o bind and loop2 is mounted with --devnodes.
