If they do not change process name, and you know some shell programming, it should be as simple as something like this:

```
for PROCNAME in bitchx irssi; do
  echo "Checking for ${PROCNAME}"
  PIDS=$(ps h -opid -C ${PROCNAME})
  for P in $PIDS; do
    grep envID: /proc/${P}/status
  done
  echo
done
```
