Hi,

i've just installed few VE using openvz, and like usual, added some monitoring for allocated resources.

One problem occurs: i have a VE running MySQL and the memory usage show 100%.

free -m show :

```
Mem:      281      281      0      0      0      0
-/+ buffers/cache:      281      0
Swap:      0      0      0
```

Even if i increase the resources (privmpages, oom, vmguar, etc), the amount of available memory is still 281Mb and is still used at 100%

The config for this VE is the same as another that i use in production on a similar hardware and software, and the other one does not show this "weird" behaviour.

Does anybody have an idea?
