Hello,

after installing and successfully running one OpenVZ VPS I wasn't able to ping or ssh to the VPS. After analyzing a little bit I came to the following:

- 1) host venet0 isn't configured even after `vzctl start 101`
- 2) venet0 in the guest (vps) is set to 127.0.0.1

Is this normal ? I've assigned 10.0.0.1 to the VPS and if I manually configure host's venet0 to 10.0.0.2 and guest's venet0 to 10.0.0.1 (through `vzctl exec`) I'm being able to ping and ssh to the vps.

Also, could someone point me to some detailed information about the OpenVZ networking concept ? Is it like vmware (separate interfaces) ? Is it like jail (ethernet aliases) ? The only thing I found about networking was "`vzctl set XYZ --ipadd A.B.C.D`" :)
